



How to download & save high-res video from your CameraMatics camera(s):


1. There are several ways to do this. We recommend you select an event from inside the AI-triggered or G-force triggered Driving Events. Click on Driving Events:




2. The list of events will default to the past 7 days. You can click the calendar button to change the date range that you want to display.




3. Click the date range that you want to display and click apply.




4. Click inside any Driving Event box to show the event data in low resolution.




- The low-resolution video, still capture, overhead view, g-force and speed data will load & will then be ready to play.



- To download high resolution data, click the download button.




- The date and time will default to the video event that you selected - and you can change that, (e.g., 15 seconds earlier). Click to select which camera lens(es) from which you want to download high resolution video.




